If you are a big fan of Steven Spielberg's E.T. you are surely going to like this. According to The Sun researchers led by UFOlogist Nick Pope, a former Defence ministry Chief, have already compiled a list of sites in Britain most visited by extraterrestrials.

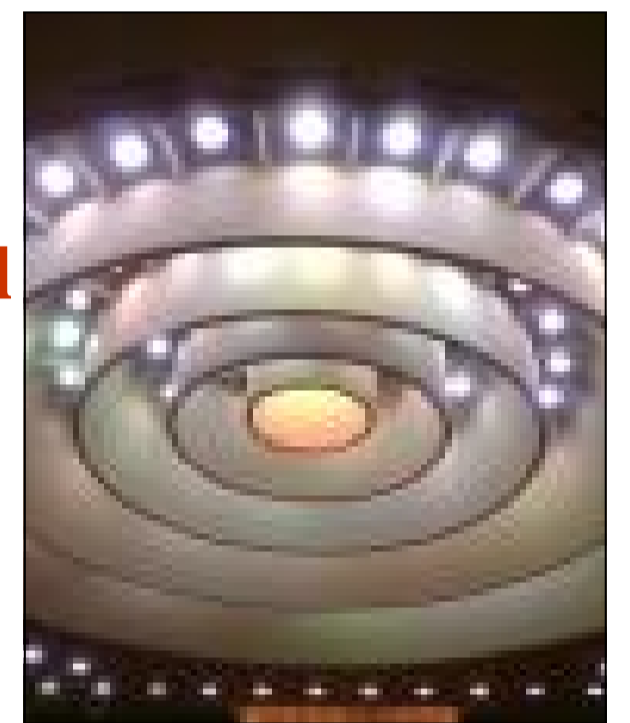
“ Our hotspots exhibit up to 20 times as many sightings as anywhere else. It is difficult to arrive at a precise number but it is certainly possible to gauge the intensity of current UFO activity,” he was quoted as saying.

The top 10 hotspots to look for aliens:

-Bonnybridge: A town near Falkirk that is considered to be the world's UFO capital with more than 100 sightings to date. Flying saucers and hovering cigars are the two most common sights.

-Cley Hill: It is famous for crop circles and many people believe the patterns are caused by spaceships.

-The Great Orme: A remote beauty spot on the North coast of Wales, this place has been the subject of intense extra-terrestrial activity since 1997.



-Bedhampton: Musician Abby Parker videoed a UFO over this suburb of Havant, Hampshire in May 2002.



-Walthamstow: UFO's have been spotted in this suburb of East London.

-Bonsall: A village near Matlock, Derbys witnessed UFO activity when housewife Sharon Rowlands shot a video showing a pulsating disc that changed colours and hovered for several minutes before it then flipped over and zoomed away.

-Rendlesham: A group of American airmen were confronted by an alien spaceship in Rendlesham Forest on two nights in December 1980.

-Bexleyheath: Children reported seeing an alien spaceship in 1955, making the Kent suburb one of the earliest UFO sites in the world.

-Glastonbury: The scene of many sightings over the years



Close encounter at Great Orme

ALIEN abductions are generally considered the stuff of legend, Hollywood, and conspiracy theories.

However new research by brewing giant Grolsch has named the **Great Orme** as one of Britain's top places for extra-terrestrial kidnappings. As part of an out-of-this-world advertising campaign, the Dutch company points to a catalogue of reported sightings which make the Llandudno beauty spot the UK's third most likely spot to witness a close encounter of the space kind.

They included multiple UFO sightings in 1997 and a family which claimed to have lost five hours after being followed by a triangular shaped craft.

Conwy tourism bosses said the beauty spot figured so highly.

“They welcome everybody, they said, even those from beyond planet Earth.”

"We have visitors from across the globe already and we would be happy to welcome those from further afield also," said Coun Eddie Woodward, cabinet member for economic development and regeneration, which includes tourism. They were delighted

"Llandudno has something for everybody."

There have been hundreds of UFO sightings across North Wales stretching back decades. One of the most famous cases was in the Berwyn mountains in 1974 when a huge explosion was heard. Some witnesses claimed a UFO had crash landed.

Although tongue in cheek, UFO researcher Nick Pope says there is a serious side to the mystery. Nick, who works for the Ministry of Defence, said

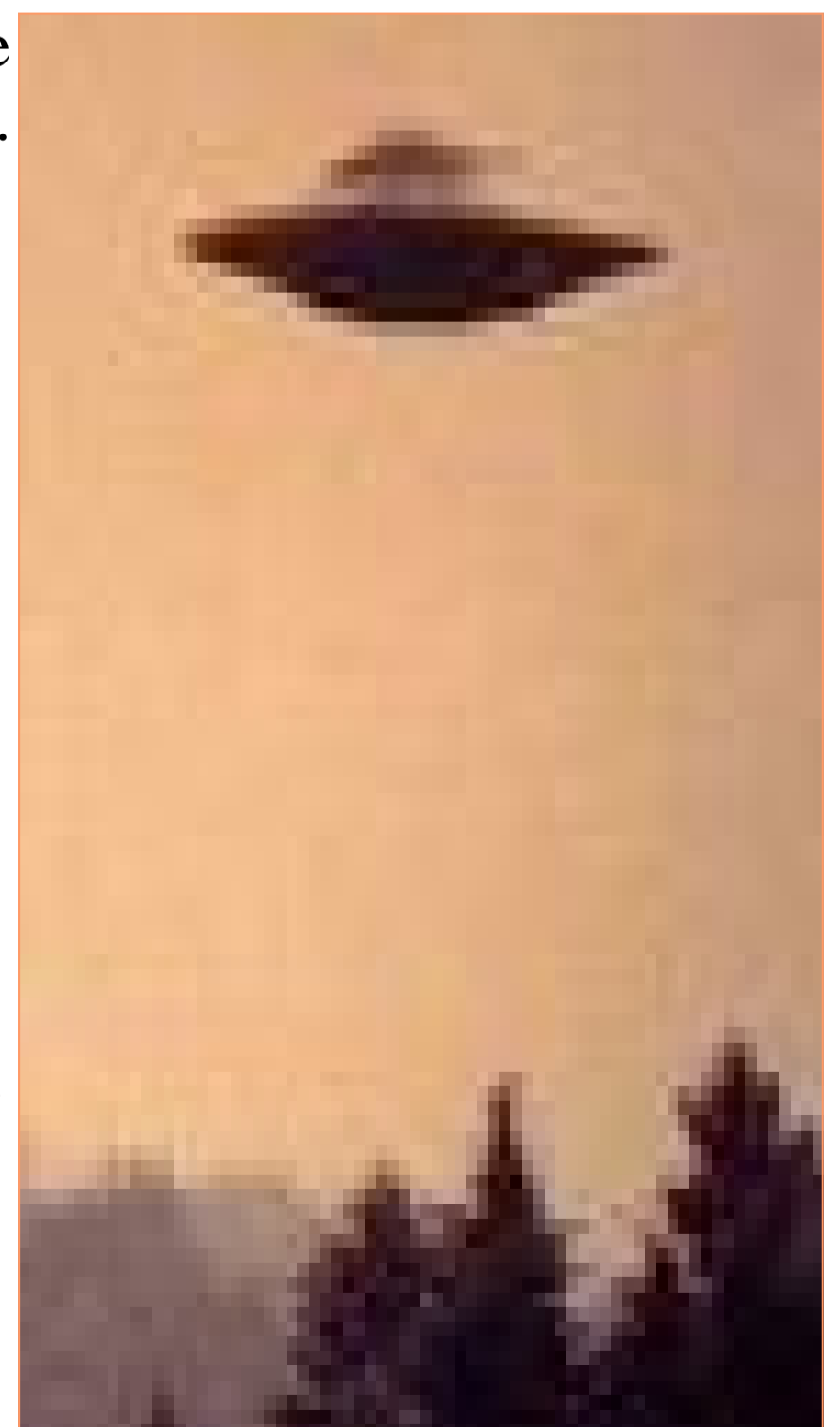
"There are literally hundreds of sightings across the UK every year, not just North Wales."

"The vast majority are simply mistaken sightings of aircraft, weather balloons, satellites, hoaxes and such like.

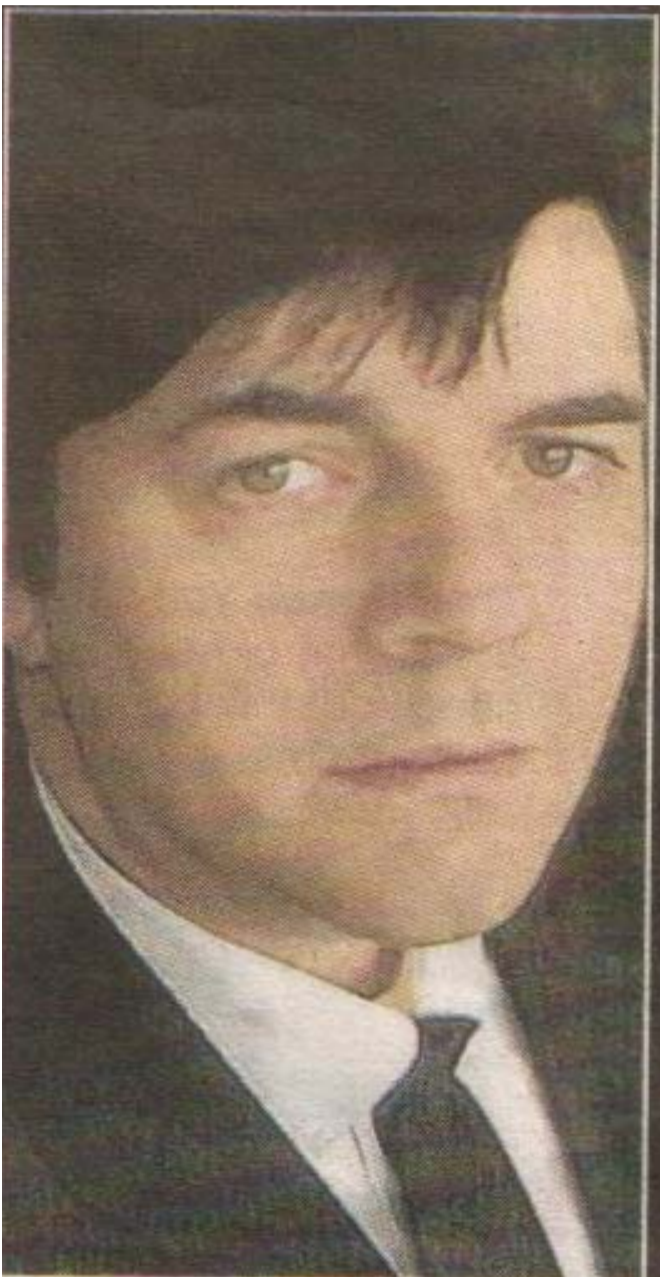
"But there is a small hardcore of really interesting cases, for example, which come from police officers, pilots and military personnel.

"With abduction cases, there are psychological explanations such as vivid dreams or sleep paralysis, but again there is a small hardcore of cases which are extremely interesting.

"The honest answer to what I think is going on is that I just don't know."

UFO CLAIM: Tom Slemen

A UFO expert claims loud bangs heard across North Wales and Merseyside just before Christmas were by a flying saucer allegedly seen over **Snowdonia**.

News reports at the time of the incident on December 21 suggested the bangs and earth tremors were the result of sonic boom from one of the RAF's new Typhoon jet fighter-planes on exercise over the North Sea.

But Tom Slemen, an acknowledged expert on the supernatural, says the first boom was heard at the same time as a religious minister from Cheshire and his two friends out walking in **Snowdonia** saw a craft resembling a silvered lens - the classic flying saucer shape - appear and hover over the mountain range.

Later, says Mr Slemen, the men saw a Typhoon jet swoop in towards the object only to be stopped in mid-air "as if by some giant invisible hand", and turned on its end.

Shortly afterwards, the flying object appeared to be chased off by two more fighter-jets.

"The high-speed departure towards the north generated another sonic boom which shook the ground." said Mr Slemen.

"The sinister force holding the Typhoon released its powerful grip, and the plane quickly restarted, and it rocketed out of its descent.

"All three planes curved around the mountain and went off at phenomenal speeds towards the North, apparently in hot pursuit of the UFO. Within seconds, the blue lights of the planes' afterburners vanished into the distance."

Mr Slemen claims the reverend and his friends were later warned by several anonymous people over their telephones not to report what they had seen.

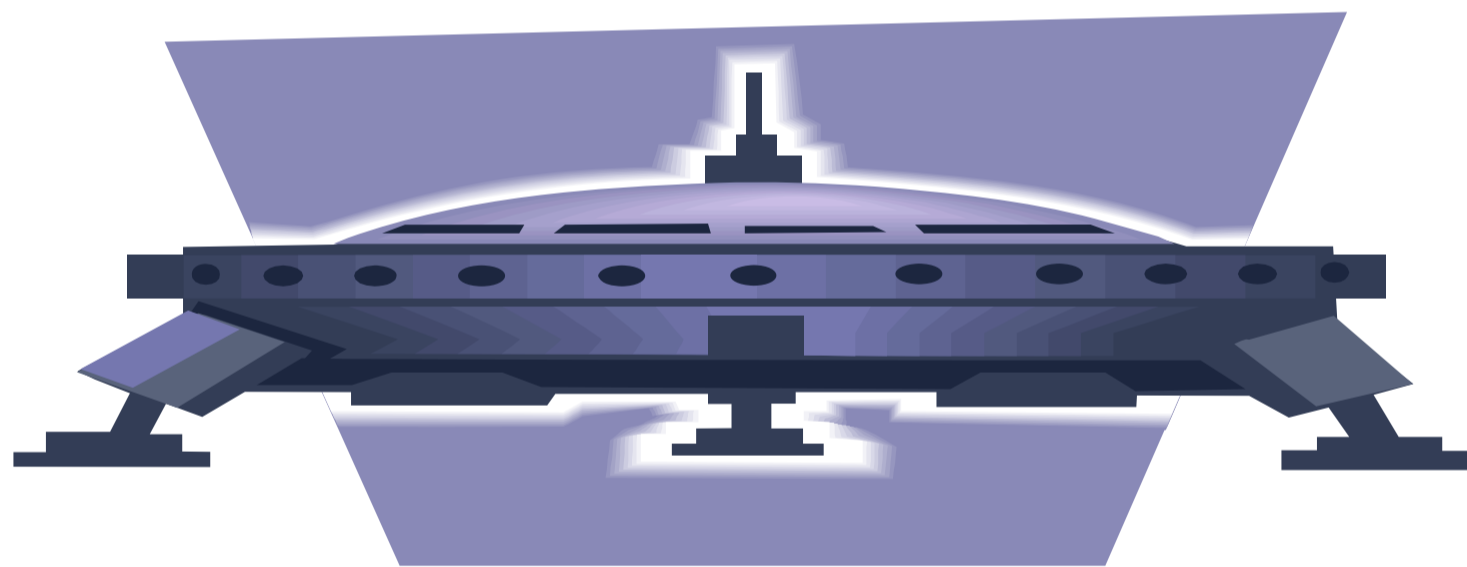


ALIEN CRUISER

One of the weirdest cases reported to the Welsh Federation of Independent Ufologists is the multiple sighting of UFOs - except one family got too close for comfort and were apparently abducted.

The strange and disturbing events began to unfold when for several nights an elderly man living by the Little Orme, Conwy, was troubled by what he called "frightening" beams of light over the Great Orme. Unfortunately for one family travelling by car to the area at the same time on November 10 1997, that was the night they had an unexplained encounter. They could not account for several 'lost' hours when they suddenly became aware of resuming their journey, according to investigator **Margaret Fry**. She was told of their account by a friend of the family who were said to have been advised by officials not to come forward.

Margaret says the couple and their children were driving on the Bodfair/Landernog road when they found their car engulfed by a purple triangular craft. The next thing they remember is that the purple craft had gone. "But they could not account for considerable hours of time lost," said Margaret. "The male was having trouble afterwards with a top molar tooth and he had to go to the dentist's," she said. "A black unknown object fell out while he was at the dentist's - but he had no fillings," she said.



Margaret says that the man reported the family's encounter to the authorities and he was said to have been visited twice by air force personnel and requested not to speak publicly about the matter.

Despite the sketchy details, Margaret is interested in the witness account because of the sightings in the same area and on the same night by the elderly man - and that of a local businessman who also had a close encounter with a craft described as an alien cruise ship. The third sighting was by the businessman who says he saw a huge craft the shape of a "child's spinning top" while he was driving along the same road as the family who claim to have been abducted. Margaret says the man, who sketched an outline of what he saw, told her he stopped his vehicle to look at the craft which he described as being as big a football pitch and hovering above buildings in the village of Llandernog.

The man says the craft had a "myriad of lit windows", almost making him believe it was a cruiser-craft capable of carrying hundreds of people - or beings...

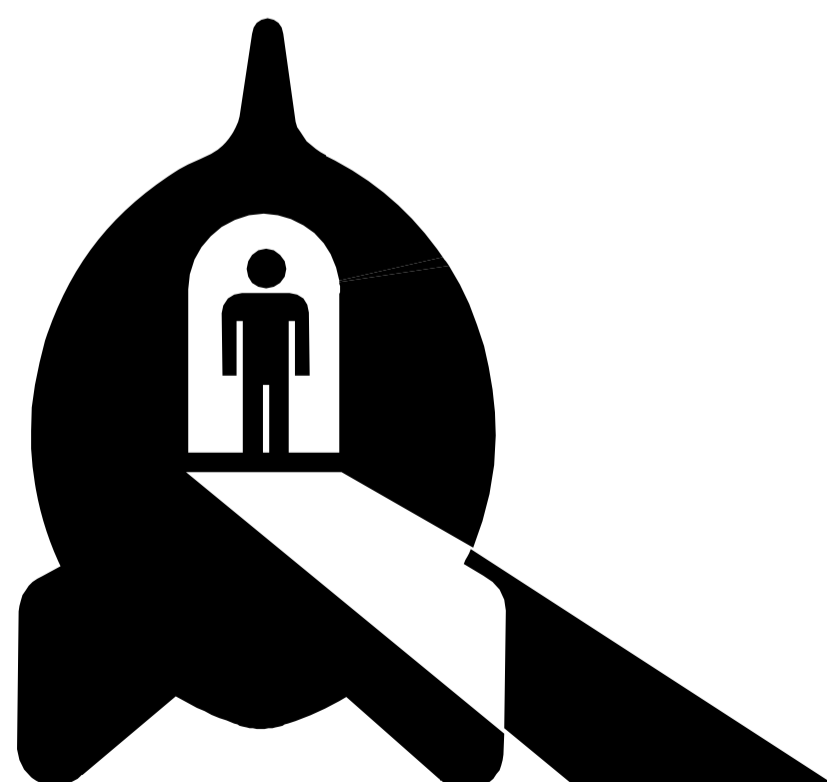
It is unlikely that you have been abducted by aliens. But this is no guarantee that extraterrestrials haven't earmarked you for a visit.

SOME COMMONLY SPOTTED UFOS

The British Isles attract a certain type of UFO.
The following are listed in order of their frequency.

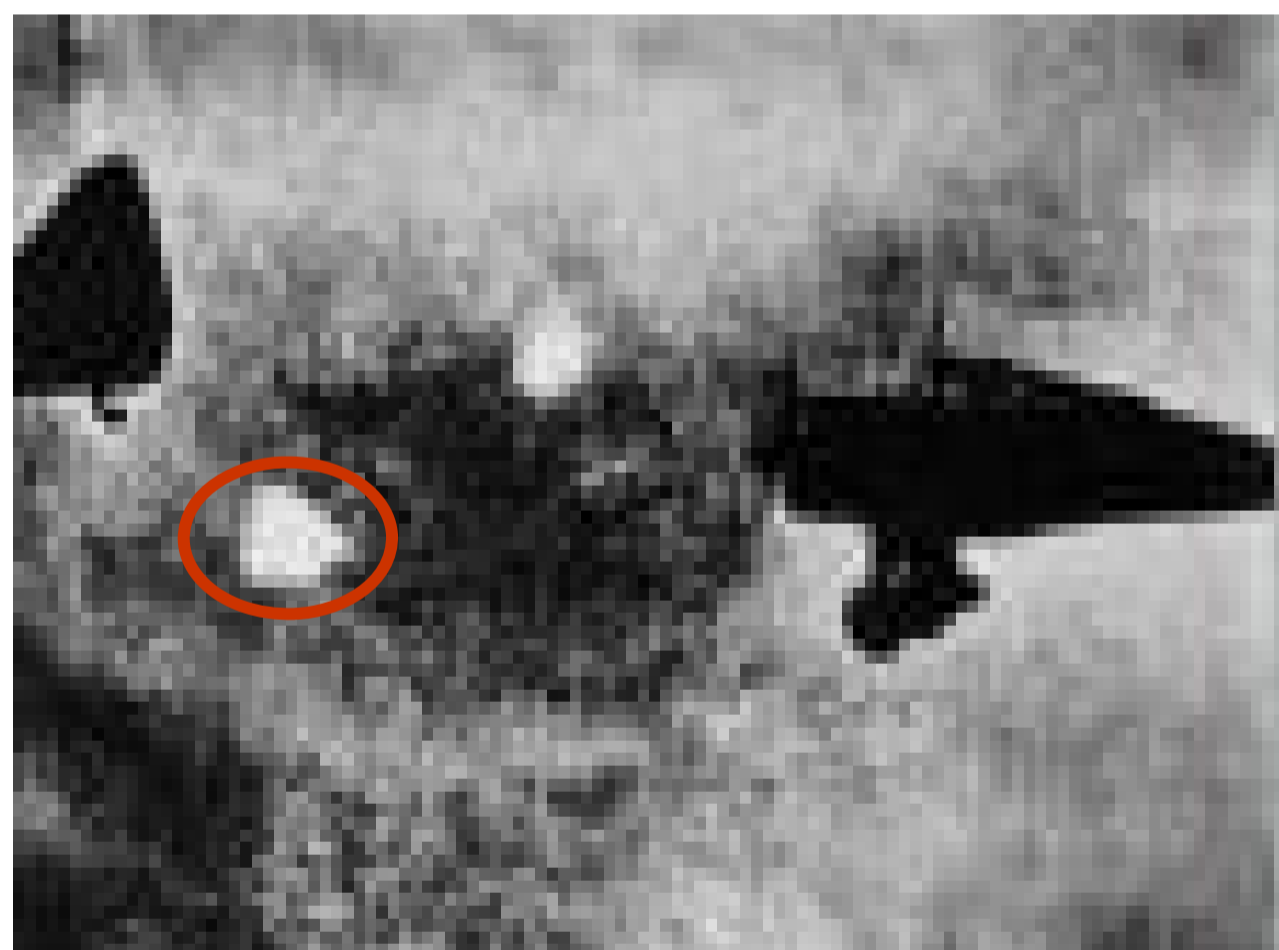
The Saucer

The classic 'flying saucer' shape, reminiscent of an up-turned dish, often accompanied by flashing lights

Large variation of in reported size and dimension

Easily forged by amateur hoaxers

Very common in sightings today



The Foo Fighter

Bright orbs of light of varying dimension from 10-100ft

Most commonly reported during World War II by pilots, and investigated by the Royal Navy and Home Office

In 2003 a man in Erdington claimed a small bright light which he described as a 'Tinkerbell' fluttered through his house.

The Delta

Triangular or wing-shaped with lights on each corner

50-100 yards in length

Occasionally attributed as a Vulcan or B-2 Stealth Bomber, or a supposed 'test' plane, the TR3B

SOME COMMONLY ENCOUNTERED ALIENS

The Universe may be inhabited by billions of lifeforms, yet only a few are known to visit Earth. The following have been repeatedly sighted around the United Kingdom and are listed in order of their frequency of sighting



GRAYS

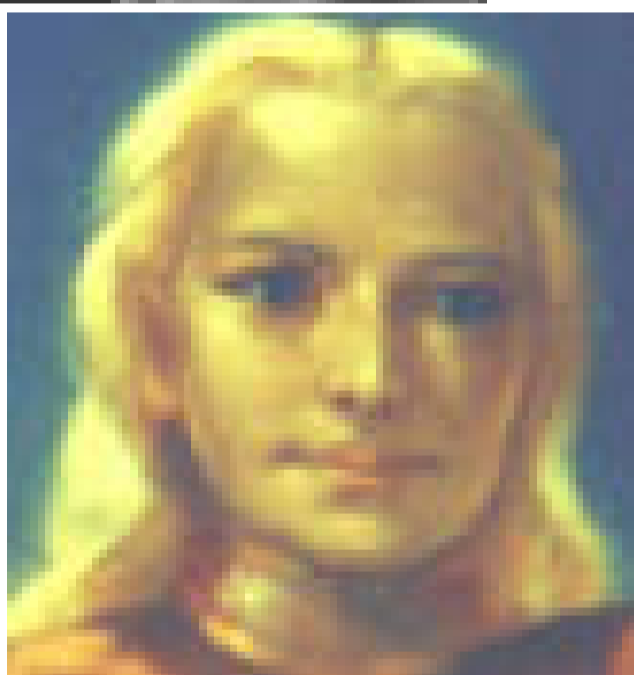
3-4ft in height

Grey in colour

Large head with insectoid eyes, a small mouth and no nose

Long thin limbs

In 1995 a Gloucestershire man told the Cheltenham Psychic Research Group that he was abducted from his car by 'gangly humanoids about 4ft tall with grey skin and wide black eyes'



Nordics

6-8ft in height

Humanoid

Blond hair, Aryan appearance

Believed to resemble humans in order to interact with us and to help co-ordinate abductions

Also known as: Agharians, Anakim, Antarticans, Atlans, Pleiadeans or Telo-sians

'Susan' from the North of England reported being abducted in the late Seventies by tall humanoid creatures with large eyes, pale skin and very blond hair



Chupacabras

3ft in height

Tan brown skin

Horned skull with elongated jaw

Red eyes

Distinctive ammonia smell

A former police officer walking the Yorkshire Moors near Ilkley in December 1987 encountered 'a small entity with pointed ears and large dark eyes' which scampered off into a disc shaped UFO
